Directions For Use:

Read the entire label before using Avocet PLX. Avocet PLX mixes readily with water to be applied as a foliar spray on emerged plants, using most standard industrial or field-type sprayers. Applications should be as spray-to-wet, with complete and uniform coverage. When less than complete coverage is expected, use a 5% Avocet PLX solution for control of annual and perennial weeds, and 5–8% solution for woody brush and trees. In accordance with label instructions, Avocet PLX may also be applied as a wick/wiper or cut-stump treatment (50–100% solution) or injected treatment (25–100% solution) on nuisance woody brush.
