Controls:

Eurasian Watermilfoil, Purple Loosestrife, Phragmites, Pickerelweed, Alligatorweed, Water Lily, Water Lettuce, Water Hyacinth, Brazilian Pepper, Willow and Salt-bush

Get Kraken for Lake, Wetland and Upland Preserve Management.

Use Kraken™ aquatic herbicide for selective and systemic control of exotic and nuisance trees, woody-brush and emergent plants. Kraken may be used to provide excellent control of submersed, floating and immersed aquatic plants in and around ponds, lakes, rivers, wetlands, non-irrigation canals, ditches and other aquatic sites. Kraken may be used

to treat whole lakes for nuisance aquatic plants, or, due to Kraken's short exposure time requirement, may be used to target aquatic weeds in portions or "spots" of large lakes, like coves, or localized areas of weed growth.

Features	Benefits
Broad weed control profile	May be used to control many nuisance plants, from exotic trees and brush, to floating, emergent and even submersed aquatic weeds like Eurasian Watermilfoil
Fast acting	Aquatic weeds treated with Kraken fall below the surface in a couple of weeks
Whole or partial lake treatments	Kraken acts fast, which makes it ideal for treating whole lakes or portions of large lakes with targeted problem areas
No recreational or livestock use restrictions	Water treated with Kraken may be used for swimming, fishing or other recreational uses immediately after application; livestock may consume water treated with Kraken with no restrictions

Directions For Use:

Kraken may be applied by aerial or conventional spray systems as a sub-surface injection or surface application. For the control of emergent and floating plants, apply 2–8 quarts of Kraken per acre as a foliar spray. For the control of submersed aquatic plants, Kraken must be applied at a concentration between .75 and 2.5 ppm. Do not apply more than 2.5 ppm of Kraken per growing season. Use ¼-2 gallons of Kraken per acre to control woody plants, trees and broadleaf weeds. Aquatic weeds treated with Kraken show herbicide symptoms (epanasty) within one day and fall below the surface and water column within 1-3 weeks following application. Nuisance trees and woody brush are controlled within one to two months.

Water treated with Kraken can not be used for irrigation until water analysis shows that the level of Kraken is below 1.0 ppb.
