Directions For Use:

Apply WingMan with ground or aerial equipment, using sufficient spray volume to provide thorough coverage. Always calibrate sprayers prior to use, and maintain continuous agitation to keep the product in suspension. Apply 4–8 oz per 1000 square feet at 7–10 day intervals, using the higher recommended rates under severe disease pressure. Use 3–5 gallons of water per 1000 square feet. When applying WingMan on golf greens, always treat aprons and approaches as well to reduce chances of carrying disease onto the green.
